

Fuel Spill Contingency Plan

At any given time on shore, there will be less than two liters of gasoline in the auger, and no additional fuel will be taken to land. Shall a spill occur on land, it will be stopped at the source immediately and spill absorbing materials will be used to absorb and stop its spread. These materials will be collected and returned to the ship for proper disposal. Standard machinery handling procedures will also be followed (i.e., two people carrying the auger at any time, minimizing carrying distances, never leaving the machinery unattended, and keeping the machinery upright) to eliminate any chance of a spill. Any spills will be reported to the Safety Officer onboard Adventure Canada.
