Denmark acknowledges receipt of the notification regarding project 'Ocean Tracking Network and wishes to participate in the ongoing environmental assessment process.

The notification has been sent for consultation to several Danish authorities and interest organizations and has been published on the The Agency for Green Transition and Aquatic Environment's website.

Denmark has the following comment:

"The Agency for Green Transition and Aquatic Environment (SGAV) has reviewed the submitted material. Based on the attached logistical plan, it appears that the project was conducted in August 2025, prior to the initiation of this ESPOO consultation process. If the investigation is to be carried out at a later time, the consultation material should clearly specify when during the season the project will take place, in order to enable a more detailed assessment of the project's impact on the affected species and environment. According to the logistical plan, it appears that whale biopsies are to be conducted. This is not described elsewhere in the consultation material. Therefore, SGAV finds it difficult to assess whether this project will have any significant impact on whales."
