Re: Termination of Assessment Activities for Peter's Expediting Ltd.'s "Pelly Lake Overland Haul" Project Proposal, pursuant to NuPPAA s. 143(6)

Dear Savigata Tootoo:

On November 4, 2025, the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a request from the Proponent to terminate the assessment of the "Pelly Lake Overland Haul" project proposal. Pursuant to s. 143(6) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14, s. 2 (*NuPPAA*) [NIRB File No.: 25RN070], this letter is an official notification to all parties that the assessment of the "Pelly Lake Overland Haul" project proposal has been **terminated** effective November 4, 2025 pursuant to s. 143(6) of the *NuPPAA*.

Should the Proponent wish to undertake the proposed project in future, a new project proposal must be submitted to the Nunavut Planning Commission in accordance with s. 76 of the *NuPPAA*. Please be advised that the *NuPPAA* prohibits the carrying out of a project, in whole or in part, where the required assessment by the NIRB has not been completed; regulatory authorities are also not authorized to issue a licence, permit or other authorizations in respect of a project where the required assessment by the NIRB has not been completed.
