PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Blue Star Corp.” project is located within the Kitikmeot region, approximately 200 kilometres (km) from Kugluktuk. The activities proposed to be extended to the new claims include general exploration (geological mapping, prospecting, geochemical sampling, and airborne and ground geophysical surveys), diamond drilling, and the establishment of temporary remote exploration camps. The program is proposed to take place from May 2026 to June 2032. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Continue to conduct exploration-related activities to assess previously identified gold targets, to conduct prospecting to locate new gold targets and to explore these targets
- The amendment seeks to add three new mineral claims to the existing exploration permits and licences for the project to support further mineral exploration activities
