2. Class 2 Archaeological & Palaeontological Permit - for the heritage resources studies (application to GN-CH mentioned in Project Description document, but not included among authorizing agencies in NPC application)	If expected to be required, an AIA will be carried out by a professional archaeologist in advance of ground disturbance activities
3. (MAYBE) DFO Fish for Scientific Purposes Licence - for fish studies (uncertain whether fish sampling will take place, please confirm)	There will no collection of infaunal organisms, however, if DFO-FMO would require one for incidental catches should there be a drilling program one will be obtained.
4. NWB Authorization? - will any sampling of freshwater be taking place (or any deposition of waste into freshwater) or are project activities restricted to the marine environment?	Not expected to be required, as if there is quarry drilling it may be able to be met with municipal supply water. However, if that is not possible then a water withdrawal license will be obtained from NWB.
