



Proponent Response:

The Proponent thanks Kivalliq Inuit Association for its review of the Victory Lake Project and appreciates KivIA's support for the proposal. The Proponent also appreciates KivIA's clear direction that the Project should follow caribou protection measures from May 15 to July 15, and that mobile protection measures should apply after that period.

The Proponent confirms that this is consistent with the current intent of the Project's Wildlife Management Plan V1.2. The current plan provides for a complete shutdown of all project activities during the Project's calving/post-calving period from 15 May to 15 July, and for mobile, trigger-based protection measures outside that period. The plan also includes wildlife observation logging, pilot spot-reports, daily crew scans, and operational pause/shutdown triggers to support field implementation.
