Thank you for the time to review my prospecting project Cache Zone 2026. It is my pleasure to inform your department of the concerns given within the commenting period ending March 31, 2026, on the NIRB website.

Within one of the email requests to Calm Air in Rankin Inlet for a large container capable of inserting one whole fuel container drum of 205L, they have approved me to take as many as I need. This container would be opened and insert drum as berm. This container can hold up to 1000L of liquid. This will be used on site as requested to be used as secondary containment.

I have attached a copy of my certificate of a course I've taken couple weeks ago called "Spill Response" and copy will be uploaded to NIRB website within this screening files.

As mentioned, about 1000L secondary container. We will now use these containers within drilling location to dump wastewater instead of creating depression. During next winter season these containers and one drum will be removed out of location.

As this is within the Inuit Owned Land designated to Whale Cove, claim area noted as IOL WC-08 by NTI I can engage with that community about this project and hear their concerns.
