The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. **Primary Land Use:** Scientific research
2. **Project summary description:** With the use of multi mesh gill-nets, the proponent will survey the Arctic Char stock of Opingivik Lake. This research will provide more data of the Cumberland Sound Arctic Char. The proponent will also be working with the Pangnirtung Hunters and Trappers Organization to collect baseline biological data. This data will contribute to a 5-year index of abundance used to assess Arctic Char stock status
3. **Location:** Qikiqtani Region; [Cumberland Sound/Opingivik Lake]
