Dear Steve Potts:

Please be advised that Section 12.7.1 (b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) states:

“a recommendation of Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) pursuant to a 12.4.4 (a) may provide for the establishment of a monitoring program for that project which may specify responsibilities for the proponent, NIRB or Government.”

Further, Section 12.7.3 (a) of the NLCA states:

Without limiting the generality of Section 12.7.2, the monitoring program set up pursuant to that section may include:

“a requirement that regulatory agencies and the proponent supply NIRB with reports and information respecting project operations and impacts, and the implementation of mitigative measures.”

According to the terms and conditions contained in the NIRB’s Screening Decision Report on April 30, 2010, for the “Baffin Gold” project proposal, Commander Resources Ltd. is to submit an Annual Report to the NIRB no later than March 31 of each year. At this time, the NIRB has not yet received Commander Resources Ltd.’s annual report for the “Baffin Gold” project for the 2012 and 2013 reporting periods.

Commander Resources Ltd. is advised to refer to the terms and conditions issued within the Screening Decision Report attached regarding the submission of your Annual Report. NIRB is requesting this information by **November 6, 2014**.
