Please be advised that I am invoking Section 25(1)(b) of the Territorial Land Use Regulations to allow further time to process your application.

As of July 9, 1996, all applications in the Nunavut Settlement Area (NSA) will be screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB), pursuant to Part 4 of Article 12 of the Nunavut Land Claim Agreement. The NIRB's primary objectives are to protect and promote the existing and future well-being of the residents and communities of the NSA, and to protect the ecosystemic integrity of the NSA.

A copy of your application has been provided to NIRB in Cambridge Bay, NU, where they will conduct an environmental screening of your application. Although your application will be screened by NIRB, the acceptance of applications and permit issuance process remains under this Department's jurisdiction.
