**RE: REQUEST FOR FINAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSION  
LAND USE PERMIT NC20050023 - TRIEX MINERALS CORPORATION**

We respectfully request a one-year extension to the term of Land Use Permit NC20050023 from 19 July 2008 to 19 July 2009. The scope of the project has not changed in any way.

Consultation efforts were begun in Kugluktuk in May of 2005 with Triex holding meetings with the KIA and KHTA. Meetings continued throughout 2005 while Triex personnel were based in Kugluktuk. In 2006 a camp was established on Kirwan Lake and consultation meetings were held in October 2006. Project updates were provided at these meetings. It is regretful that consultation, while planned for October 2007, did not take place however it is anticipated that consultation meetings will be held during the early part of the 2008 field season.
