Dear Mr. Dewar,

We respectfully request an amendment to Land Use Permit NC20050023 to include new ground. The scope of the project has not changed in any other way. Attached please find two maps, one in latitude and longitude coordinates, another in UTM coordinates, illustrating the new area being included in this amendment application.

An amendment application has been submitted to the Nunavut Water Board and a new Land Use Licence application has been submitted to the Kittikmeot Inuit Association for the areas that are located on IOL.

We began consultation efforts in Kugluktuk in May of 2005 holding meetings with the KIA and KHTA. Meetings continued throughout 2005 while Triex personnel were based in Kugluktuk. In 2006 a camp was established on Kirwan Lake. Consultation meetings were held in early October of this year. Project updates were provided at these meetings.
