Dear Mr. Nicholson:

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Starfield Resources Inc.'s (Starfield) Mineral Exploration Camp Project Proposal from the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA) on January 19, 2005. The Project Proposal submission included the following documents:

- *Kivalliq Inuit Association Application for Access to Inuit Owned Land*
- *Project Description for Starfield Resources Inc., Ferguson Lake Camp (English and Inuktitut)*
- *Starfield Resources Inc. Ferguson Lake Project Abandonment and Restoration Plan*
- *Starfield Resources Ferguson Lake Spill Contingency Plan*
- *Map of Ferguson Lake proposed and existing camp sites*
- *Map of Ferguson Lake camp layout*

Pursuant to Article 11 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), NIRB is copying this letter to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for a determination of whether the Project Proposal is in conformity with the Kivalliq Regional Land Use Plan. Once a conformity determination is made, the NPC will forward the Project Proposal with its determination and recommendations to NIRB. At that time NIRB will carry out screening of the Project Proposal in accordance with Article 12 of the NLCA.

In addition, NIRB advises Starfield that the information requested in the attached NIRB Screening Part 2 Project Specific Information Requirements (PSIR) Form for Mineral Exploration will be required to screen the Project Proposal.
