Re: Kiggavik Licence 2BE-KIG1318 – Amendment Application (NIRB File No. 06AN085)

AREVA Resources Canada Inc. (AREVA) has requested amendment of the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) Licence to clarify between “Kiggavik lease” and “Kiggavik Project”. The current scope of the licence includes both the St. Tropez and Kiggavik areas; however, St. Tropez is identified as part of the Kiggavik lease. The amendment request is for clarification that the Kiggavik and St. Tropez areas are collectively termed as the Kiggavik Project. The application is enclosed for the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) and the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) review to determine whether additional conformity review and/or screening decision are required.

AREVA believes the amendment request remains consistent with the activities previously considered within the original NPC conformity determination and the NIRB screening decision. Exploration at the Kiggavik Project received a positive conformity determination against the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan (KRLUP) on December 15, 2006. The Kiggavik Project received a positive screening decision by the NIRB on April 3, 2007, and the NIRB later issued additional recommendations in a letter dated August 30, 2007. AREVA remains committed the conformity requirements of the KRLUP and to the recommendations found in the NIRB screening decision report and subsequent conditions. AREVA is confident that the current environmental protection measures and supporting management plans will ensure protection of the environment during operations.
