**RE: RENEWAL OF LAND USE PERMIT #N2007/X0011, RIGHT OF WAY - WINTER OVERLAND
TRANSPORT OF SUPPLIES, STARFIELD RESOURCES FERGUSON LAKE EXPLORATION PROJECT**

Starfield Resources respectfully requests an extension to the Land Use Permit #N2007/X0011, a Right of Way Permit which allows for the continued overland winter hauling of supplies to support the exploration program at Ferguson Lake.

Transportation is provided locally, historically by M&T Enterprises based out of Rankin Inlet. Supplies are hauled overland using Challengers. Overland hauling is only during the winter/early spring months when there is still snow covering the frozen ground. The route is recorded with GPS and is available to Inspector's upon request.

Starfield has a current Right of Way agreement with the Kivalliq Inuit Association to permit the overland haul over Inuit Owned Lands.

Supplies hauled include fuel, machinery, parts, etc.
