A CAT TEAM CONSISTING OF CATERPILLAR CHALLENGERS WITH SLEDS WILL MAKE ON TRIP EACH FROM RANKIN INLET AND ARVIAT BRINGING IN FUEL AND SUPPLIES AND REMOVING REMEDIATED MATERIAL

THE TRANSPORT OF FUEL AND SUPPLIES INTO AND OUT OF FERGUSON LAKE CAMP IS NOT EXPECTED TO HAVE SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE EFFECTS BECAUSE THE TRAIL FOLLOWS LAKES AND AREAS OF HIGH SNOW COVER DURING MID-WINTER. THERE WILL BE NO TRAVEL ALONG BANKS ADJACENT TO LAKES OR RIVERS OR ON UNFROZEN BODIES OF WATER. CAT DRIVERS WILL STOP WHENEVER CARIBOU ARE ENCOUNTERED AND ALLOW THEM TO PROCEED WITH MINIMAL DISTURBANCE. ANY HYDROCARBON SPILLS ON SNOW AND ICE WILL BE IMMEDIATELY CLEANED UP AND REMOVED FROM SITE IN A SEALABLE CONTAINER.
