RE: Request for Annual Report for “Amer Lake” Project Proposal

Dear Graham Gill:

Please be advised that Section 12.7.1 (b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) states:

“a recommendation of Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) pursuant to a 12.4.4 (a) may provide for the establishment of a monitoring program for that project which may specify responsibilities for the proponent, NIRB or Government.”

Further, Section 12.7.3 (a) of the NLCA states:

Without limiting the generality of Section 12.7.2, the monitoring program set up pursuant to that section may include:

“a requirement that regulatory agencies and the proponent supply NIRB with reports and information respecting project operations and impacts, and the implementation of mitigative measures.”

According to the terms and conditions contained in the NIRB’s Screening Decision Reports on August 22, 2007 and January 12, 2012, for the “Amer Lake” project proposal, Uranium North Resources Corp. is to submit an Annual Report to the NIRB no later than January 31st of each year. At this time, the NIRB has not yet received Uranium North Resources Corp.’s annual report for the “Amer Lake” project proposal for the 2012 and 2013 reporting period.

Uranium North Resources Corp. is advised to refer to the terms and conditions issued within the Screening Decision Report (attached) regarding the submission of your Annual Report. NIRB is requesting this information by **November 6, 2014**.
