We wish to extend Land Use Permit #N2007X0043. There was no exploration on 5050's property last year, and this permit had no activity.

We are joint venture partners with Hornby Bay Minerals, and intend to participate in their proposed seismic survey. As such, the parties that can provide the most details, and have authorization to discuss this request are Bogdan Nitescu at Hornby Bay and Grant Newman at Kikiak.

Kikiak will be the contractor responsible for building the ice strip at McGregor Lake. McGregor Lake has had several successful Herc-sized ice strips built previously. The intent is for equipment to be transported to McGregor Lake, and to have materiel for exploration delivered to the ice strip. As a contingency, permission is also sought for seismic truck(s) to traverse the same route, in case the Herc, for weather or safety reasons cannot land at McGregor Lake.

The equipment that Kikiak (Grant Newman) intends to use includes:

- >> 1- D6H dozer with sled
- >> 1-PB 200 snowcat
- >> 1- 299C tracked skidsteer loader
- >> 1-500gal. double walled fuel tank
- >> 1- 7000w diesel generator
- >> 1- welder


