The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Hapag-Lloyd's Cruise Ship project proposal from the Canadian Wildlife Service (CWS) on April 27, 2007. The project proposal submission included the following documents:

- *NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in English*
- *Application for CWS Permit*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in English*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in Inuktitut*

Your project appears to be located in an area which requires conformity to the North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan. Pursuant to Article 11 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), the project proposal must be sent to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for a conformity determination with this Plan. This can be done by visiting the PLANNER website (<http://planner.nunavut.ca>). PLANNER is an Internet permitting service which is used by a number of agencies in Nunavut. On the main PLANNER webpage, on the left side frame of the page, you will see a **New Proposals** heading which has an "apply for project name and password" link. Once a conformity determination is made, the NPC will forward its determination and recommendations to NIRB. At that time NIRB will carry out screening of the Project Proposal in accordance with Article 12 of the NLCA.
