Dear Mr. Barry,

As per the terms and conditions of INAC Land Use Permit N2004C0005, this report is submitted to the Nunavut Impact Review Board to summarize 2009 activities for the Hackett River project, owned and operated by Sabina Gold & Silver Corp. (Sabina). The labelled items in the report (a, b, c, etc.) correspond to the items outlined in Part 7 of the General Terms and Conditions (page 3 of 10) of NIRB Screening Decision 04EN012 and 06EN033.

Sabina was in full compliance with the terms and conditions of this license.

Sabina is actively exploring the Hackett River property mineral rights encompassing the primary exploration camp at Hackett River (Camp Lake), and the outlying Hackett claims and at Wishbone (e.g. D'Arcy Lake). All of these properties are located on both Crown and Inuit-Owned Land, located approximately 104 km south of the community of Bathurst Inlet in the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut. Advanced exploration programs have been carried out in previous years. Similar activities are expected to be undertaken in 2010 and beyond as the project continues to advance toward eventual production.
