TITLE: Climate change effects of a changing cryosphere on Northern lakes

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

Climate change is projected to cause significant change to arctic aquatic ecosystems. Changes in the thickness and composition of arctic lake ice covers will produce second order impacts on lake biological productivity and ecology. The most important effects are likely to result from changes in temperature (ice growth) and precipitation (ice cover composition). While a number of models have been developed to model these changes, their validation has been stalled by lack of relevant field data. Relevant field data will be obtained by sampling of lake ice thickness during spring 2011.
