Thank you for your letter of May 15, 2015.

We write to inform NIRB that Tundra Copper has carefully monitored comments posted during the recently completed public comment phase of screening and is formulating a detailed response to address the concerns that were raised.

Further to your request that Tundra Copper provide a response to your letter by May 29, 2015, we ask you consider the alternative deadline of June 5, 2015. Given our scheduled consultations in Kugluktuk for the week of May 25 including multi-party (HTO, CBC, Hamlet, KIA) input to our proposed Wildlife Management Plan and preparation of what will be a detailed, multi-document filing, the additional week would assist us in providing a better quality response.
