The proposed “Environmental Waste Processing Facility” project is located within the Qikiqtani region, within the city limits of Iqaluit and on a Heavy Industrial zoned lot. The Proponent intends to conduct remediation of hydrocarbon contaminated soils, in addition to management of contaminated water. The program is proposed to take place from May 2016 to and to continue as long as operations are commercially viable. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Continuation of activities associated with contaminated water management
- Establishment of industrial and household hazardous and non-hazardous waste management
- Establishment of contaminated soil management
