Hello,

Although there were no specific comments on the Spill Prevention Plan during the NIRB comment period, the document was recently updated with some minor revisions.

Revisions include the following:

- Section 1.1 - an additional sentence was added which reads "A copy of this SPP will be kept on site at an appropriate location near to storage areas for fuels and any other hazardous materials."
- Section 4.2.1 – an additional sentence was added which reads "Standard spill kits typically contain absorbent booms, socks, pads, waste bags and ties, and PPE such as gloves and goggles. Further details on the contents of the spill kits will be provided by the successful contractor."
