

LAND USE PERMIT CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF LAND USE PERMIT NO. LUP06-600-013

TERM:

1. The term of this permit shall be for a period commencing on the 7th day of September, 2012 and ending on the 7th day of September, 2013

USE

2. This permit is in respect of the construction of the Berms and storage of 73,800 liters of Fuel.

CGS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

3. The Permittee shall not conduct this land use operation on any lands not designated in the accepted application, unless otherwise approved in writing by an authorized Departmental representative.
4. The Permittee shall not conduct any part of the land use operation within 100 metres of any privately owned land or structure unless otherwise approved in writing by an authorized Departmental representative.
5. The Permittee shall not conduct any part of the land use operation on any private or leased land without first having received permission from the owner or lessee.
6. The Permittee shall not construct earth approaches abutted to the roadbed on any public highway or road without prior written approval of the Director, ED&T.
7. The Permittee shall display a copy of this permit in a conspicuous place in each campsite established to carry out this land use operation.
8. The Permittee shall return the land to its original state after development has been completed.
9. The Permittee shall have a copy of this permit on the site of operation at all times.
10. The Permittee shall conspicuously display the land use permit number on all vehicles and equipment
11. The Permittee shall provide to the authorized Departmental representative at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to commencement of this land use operation the following information:
 - a) Person, or persons, in charge of the field operation to whom notices, order and reports may be served;
 - b) Alternatives;
 - c) All the indirect methods of contacting the above person(s).
12. The permittee shall enter into a land lease for use of the road being constructed, at terms and conditions to be determined by CGS, before the expiration of this permit and operational use of the road.

NIRB TERMS AND CONDITIONS

13. The permittee will comply with all the terms stated in the Project Certificate as they apply to this permit.

ENVIRONMENT

14. The permittee shall ensure that the land use area is kept clean and tidy at all times
15. The permittee shall not discharge or deposit any refuse substance or other waste materials in any body of

water or on the banks thereof, which will impair the quality of the waters of the natural environment

16. The permittee shall ensure that any chemical fuels or wastes associated with the project do not spread to the surrounding lands or enter into any water body. Spills shall be cleaned up immediately
17. The permittee shall immediately report all spills of petroleum or hazardous chemicals to the 24 hour spill report line at 1-867-920-8130.
