- a) **Summary of Activities**      Please see attached January 14, 2016 letter to INAC summarizing 2015 activities
  - b) **Work Plan for 2016**      Environmental baseline work
  - c) **Wildlife Encounters**      A table of wildlife sightings is attached. Additional details are included in the, 2015 Chidliak 2015 Environmental Baseline Report. This report is being saved to DVD and couriered to your office (Attention: Jaida Ohokannoak)
  - d) **Observed Local Users**      None observed in 2015 in Project Area. Activities within the project area have been concentrated to the interior of Hall Peninsula and away from high use areas by local land users.
  - e) **Local Hiring**      1395 person days for northern hires. Positions included trail Scouts, Cook’s Assistant, Heavy Equipment Operators, Camp Maintenance, Laborers, Environmental Assistant. Northern personnel were hired by Peregrine and its subcontractors.



- f) **Consultations** A catalogue of community consultations undertaken up to the end of 2015 is attached. The results of these meeting have helped Peregrine understand local traditional land use and the seasonal cycle in which these activities take place and communicate project details to local communities. Since 2013 Peregrine's work is concentrated to the interior of Hall Peninsula and away from high use areas by local land users. Most local interest in the project is with respect to employment. Peregrine will continue its consultation efforts.
- g) **Wildlife Monitoring** Wildlife logs are actively maintained. Wildlife logs are introduced to project personnel every field season as part of the camp safety induction. Most wildlife observations are birds. Caribou have been observed within and beyond the project area but none in the immediate vicinity of work activities. Local bear monitors are hired for safety and security.
- h) **Wildlife Mitigation** Peregrine has observed low densities of wildlife in the interior of the Hall Peninsula where project activities take place. Since 2013 activities are confined to a much smaller geographical area as work is focused in an area around kimberlites Ch-6 and Ch-7. Preliminary ecological mapping conducted in 2014 concludes that the majority of the area *immediately surrounding* the work areas is bedrock and block-field with limited vegetation carrying capacity.
- i) **Project Specific Terms** Project specific terms are compiled and presented to the Camp Manager and Project Manager at the beginning of every field season. A summary of these details are present to all employees (Peregrine and Contractor) as part of the camp safety induction. Mangers are responsible for the day to day oversight of terms and conditions. Peregrine strives for good work practices and a safe work site. The terms and conditions of the permit area consistent with good work practises. Peregrine believes that its field activities area consistent with the terms and conditions and inspections by land use inspectors are consistent with these belief. Peregrine would welcome more frequent field inspections to audit our activities.

Re: Annual Report – Chidliak Project – N2012C0024 – Calendar year 2015

---

Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. (“Peregrine”) holds AANDC class “A” land use permit N2012C0024. This permit authorizes land use activities at Peregrine’s Chidliak Project located 130 kilometres northwest of Iqaluit on 250K NTS maps 25O, 25P, 26A and 26B. The permit was issued June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2013 and expires on June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

The following sections detail activities that took place on Crown Lands under permit N2012C0024 during the calendar year 2015. All activities took place on Crown Lands primarily within the confines of 1:50,000 scale National Topographic Maps 26B01, 26B02, 26B07 and 26B08. All activities are illustrated in the attached Map1 entitled 2015 *Land Use Activities*.

### **Winter Program 2015**

The Winter 2015 program was undertaken to obtain a bulk kimberlite sample from the CH-7 kimberlite. The program commenced on January 7, 2015 with the opening of Sunrise Camp. Equipment, people and supplies were mobilized by fixed wing aircraft and helicopter to the ice airstrip adjacent to the camp. Once mobilization was complete, the camp was closed and all personnel moved to Discovery Camp 10.5 kilometers east of Sunrise Camp. Large diameter drilling commenced on March 21, 2015.

A total of six large diameter (71 centimeter) holes were completed at CH-7 with the shallowest hole measuring 75 meters depth and the deepest drilled to 240 meters. At the completion of drilling, all drill holes were capped with metal plugs. The location of the large diameter drill holes are illustrated on Map 2 entitled *2015 Drilling at CH-7 Kimberlite*. Drill fines were deposited in a preapproved rock basin site 2.75 kilometers north of Discovery Camp. The recovered kimberlite sample was placed in bulk sample bags and flown to Iqaluit where it was stored in sea containers until the sealift arrived in August.

Peregrine had planned on utilizing a winter trail between the City of Iqaluit and Discovery Camp. The trail was utilized twice with the first trip occurring on January 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup> and the second trip occurring on March 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>. Peregrine halted trail travel after the second trip as there was insufficient snow between Iqaluit and the McKeand River to support continued trail use.



At the worksite snow was sparse and perpetually drifting. The original southern inter-camp route was deemed to have insufficient snow cover and an alternative route was sought to the north. Through vigilant snow grooming personnel were able to establish a 19 kilometer trail connecting Sunrise Camp, Discovery Camp, CH-7 and the drill fines disposal area. Qualitative observations from a number of individuals indicate that the winter was colder, windier and with less snow than in previous years.

A total of 11 spills occurred during the program. Of these 10 were below the reporting threshold (between 0.06 litres and 15 litres). One spill on April 24, 2015 was above the reporting threshold and was reported to the Spill Hotline. All spills were cleaned up, documented and contaminated materials incinerated in the camp incinerator (**Make:** *Inciner8*, **Model:** *A400*). Table 3 details the spills that occurred during the winter 2015 program.

### **Summer 2015**

The Summer 2015 program commenced on July 20, 2015. The program was undertaken to conduct core drilling at the CH-6 and CH-7 kimberlites and conduct the seventh consecutive year environmental baseline surveys. All operations were based out of the Discovery Camp and access to the project was by helicopter.

A total of six NQ size (47.6mm) core drill holes were completed; two holes at CH-6 and four holes at CH-7. Core holes varied from 177.5m depth to 260m depth. Summer 2015 drill holes are illustrated on Map 2 and Map 3. Sampled core was shipped to Iqaluit by air.







Map 1: 2015 Land Use Activities
