PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Kahuna Diamond Project” project is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 54 kilometres (km) from northeast of Rankin Inlet, approximately 37 kilometres (km) from Chesterfield Inlet. The Proponent intends to conduct a diamond exploration program on the Kahuna mineral Claim. The program is proposed to take place from March 1, 2017 to March 1, 2019. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Diamond Exploration: Prospecting, geological mapping, and rock, till, and soil sampling;
- Bulk sampling at three (3) sample sites, including blasting, drilling, and excavation of up to 500 tonnes of sampling material/site, for a total bulk sampling program of up to 1,500 tonnes;
- Daily transportation of personnel, equipment, and materials during operational periods via helicopter from Rankin Inlet;
- Seasonal development of a winter road between the community of Rankin Inlet
