PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Amaruq Exploration Access Road-Additional Quarry Amendment” project is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 150 kilometres (km) from Baker Lake approximately 50 kilometres (km) from Meadowbank Gold Mine. The Proponent intends to conduct develop additional hard rock quarries to allow the approved Amaruq Exploration Access Road. The program is proposed to take place from March 2017 to December 2025. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Development of six (6) additional hard rock quarry/borrow pit sites;
- Use of additional heavy equipment;
- Use of explosives for blasting of quarry sites;
- Use of fuel for equipment;
