Kivalliq Energy Corporation is pleased to submit to NIRB an Angilak Property 2016 Annual Report and a 2017 Work Plan.

Exploration work undertaken on the Angilak Property in 2016 was conducted entirely on mineral claims and included the collection of 704 Enzyme Leach soil sampling, 172 conventional soil samples and 39 heavy mineral samples. In addition three historic trenches at the Yat target were cleaned out and five new trenches were excavated. From these, a total of 49 channel samples and 51 rock samples were collected and sent for analysis. Environmental baseline monitoring included the collection of 15 water quality samples, ten of these from lakes located within the boundaries of IOL RI-30.

Kivalliq Energy's 2017 exploration work plan includes 3,000 to 5,000 metres of diamond drilling, ground geophysical surveying, prospecting, soil sampling and continued environmental baseline monitoring. All exploration activities and target areas contemplated for 2017 are presently permitted and authorized under Kivalliq's existing permits and licenses from INAC, KIA and the NWB. Operations are planned to start in May and continue into September.
