On March 2, 2017 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a request from the University of Manitoba (U of M) to terminate the assessment of the "Canadian Arctic Tidal Transect Research and Information Network – Ice Covered Ecosystem (CAT-TRAIN-ICE): Amendment to NRI#04 002 17R-M" project modification proposal. Pursuant to subsection 143(6) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NuPPAA) [NIRB File No.: 10YN014], this letter is an official notification to all parties that the assessment of the "Canadian Arctic Tidal Transect Research and Information Network – Ice Covered Ecosystem (CAT-TRAIN-ICE): Amendment to NRI#04 002 17R-M" project modification proposal has been terminated effective March 2, 2017.

In accordance with section 76 and subsection 143(7) of the NuPPAA, a new project proposal may be submitted to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) in relation to the now-terminated assessment.
