RE: NPC File # 148431 [Iqaluit Marine Infrastructure – Small Craft Harbour]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

- 1- Marine based Infrastructure development including an extension to the existing breakwater, a boat launching ramp, improvement and expansion of parking/storage area at the municipal breakwater and potential improvements to the Old Causeway.
The Project is located on approximately 13 hectares of land situated on the Koojesse Inlet in Frobisher Bay near Sinaa Street in the Lower Iqaluit neighbourhood of Iqaluit.
The Project is designed to serve small boat users such as recreational users, hunters and fishermen, subsistence harvesters, marine outfitters and cruise ship tenders.
Supporting project activities during construction may include the use of the quarry to be developed for the Iqaluit Marine Infrastructure - Deep Sea Port project (NPC File # 148429) to source fill material.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.
