In response to the request, Natural Resources Canada's (NRCan) has reviewed the project amendment documents.

NRCan may be a Responsible Minister if licences for storage of explosives as per the *Explosives Act* are required in order for the project to proceed. With respect to explosives storage, NRCan does not anticipate any potential adverse effects given that explosives storage need to adhere to strict regulatory requirements which include environmental safeguards
