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<p><b>Please describe the concerns indicated above:</b></p> <p>Any concerns associated with the project in respect to Transport Canada’s mandate, the Navigation Protection Act and our duty to consult will be considered and made aware during the authorization process under the Navigation Protection Act.</p>			
<p><b>Do you have any suggestions or recommendations for this application?</b></p> <p><b>Navigation Protection</b></p> <p>The Arctic Ocean is part of the Scheduled waters listed under the Navigation Protection Act (NPA) and any work in, on, over, under, or through sections of the Arctic Ocean will require a NPA approval prior to action. The Government of Nunavut- Community and Government Services’ must submit a notice of works to the Transport Canada Prairie and Northern Region office for the Pond Inlet Marine Infrastructure project. Please indicate when the construction is scheduled to take place as well as any temporary works and construction methodology that may be required.</p> <p>Transport Canada also recommends the Government of Nunavut- Community and Government Services’ review the amendments to the Minor Works and Waters Order and self-assess to determine if any of the proposed in-water works may be considered a Minor Work. Minor works under the Order do not require notice or approval by TC.</p> <p>Transport Canada’s Navigation Protection Program will evaluate potential impacts to navigation and navigation safety related to the construction and maintenance of proposed works subject to the Navigation Protection Act. Authorization under the Navigation Protection Act may include conditional mitigation measures to address potential impacts to navigation.</p>

**Aboriginal Consultation**


Transport Canada may have a duty to consult affected Indigenous groups due to the potential departmental approvals required by the marine infrastructure construction under the Navigation Protection Act.

Based on the above activities, Transport Canada will be required to assess whether it has a duty to consult with groups who's Aboriginal or Treaty rights may be adversely impacted by the projects activities. Additionally, Transport Canada will participate in any coordinated 'whole of government' Aboriginal consultation resulting from the Northern Project Management Office and/or the NIRB environmental assessment processes.
