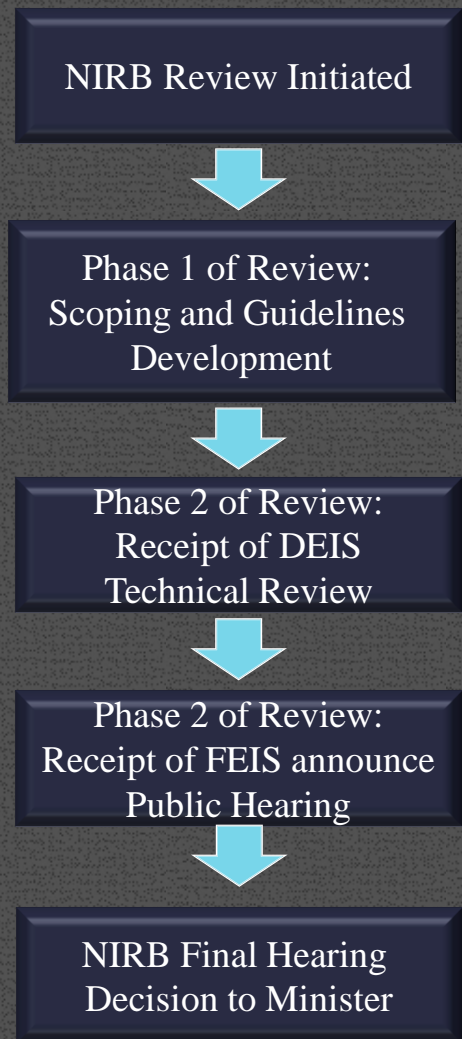

# NIRB's Review Process Overview



- Where it has been determined that a project should proceed, NIRB must issue a project certificate including any terms and conditions which have been accepted or varied by the Minister.
- Terms and conditions from the Final Hearing Report are carried forward into the Project Certificate

# Monitoring Process Overview

- The terms and conditions of NIRB project certificates must be implemented by all government departments and agencies in accordance with their authorities and jurisdictional responsibilities.
- The terms and conditions of NIRB project certificate must be incorporated into relevant permits, certificates, licences or other government approvals that the proponent may require.

- Government departments and agencies shall discuss with NIRB how best to implement the terms and conditions of NIRB project certificates and may provide NIRB with drafts of permits, certificates, licences and other government approvals.
  - Although not Government, the Regional Inuit Associations also have a strong role in implementing Project Certificate terms and conditions
- Project certificate workshop is the beginning of this dialogue
  - NIRB will be tracking the various licencing processes as they progress
  - NIRB will seek to coordinate and provide advice on implementation











# Monitoring Objectives: Nunavut Agreement

- Nunavut Agreement Section 12.7.2:

- The purpose of a monitoring program set up pursuant to Section 12.7.1 shall be:
  - (a) To measure the relevant effects of projects on the ecosystemic and socio-economic environments of the Nunavut Settlement Area;
  - (b) To determine whether and to what extent the land and resource use in question is carried out within the predetermined terms and conditions;
  - (c) To provide the information base necessary for agencies to enforce terms and conditions of land or resource use approvals; and
  - (d) To assess the accuracy of the predictions contained in the project impact assessment.
