Most significant barriers to NIRB's monitoring process:

• Clarification of the mandate of NIRB vs. other authorities or stakeholders. There is significant overlap between reporting to other agencies which duplicates work and confuses the process.

• Clarification of the intent of the condition rather than outlining the specifics so that best practices can manipulate how the condition be met and to allow for adaptation to the conditions

Wording of project phase: Identifying when the closure of a phase can be considered and whether those terms + conditions are required to be continually reported on.

Reporting requirements: Terminology does not necessarily apply to the operational phase. It can be unclear or hazardous to report back to the NIRS based on the language in this box. This year Bathinland included what they perceived the expectation on the reporting requirement is now that we are in the operational phase
