Hi Mia,

Thank you for following up.

Here are answers to your questions:

- Yes, we will be staying at the Alert station for this research
- Yes, I applied for the License for fishing for scientific purpose (LFSP) from DFO for small amounts of zooplankton. Indicated 1g of zooplankton per sampling day, maximum of 20 x 1g. I also indicated the possible collection of benthic organisms in the LSFP application, maximum of 50 organisms.
- We will be sampling from only one station but we will be collecting multiple ice cores at this station. We hope to sample sites with different ice conditions, one site with multiyear ice and one site with firstyear ice and collect cores every 4 day or so. I estimate we will be collecting between 8 to 10 cores each day of sampling. We will take part of the cores and put the remaining core back in the hole after sampling according to our sampling protocol.
