Re: Disposal at Sea Permit: 4543-2-02899 - Iqaluit Deep Sea Port

Your application has been reviewed pursuant to Part 7, Division 3 of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* (CEPA 1999). Attached is a permit authorizing the loading, transportation and disposal of dredged material at sea. As the Permittee, it is your responsibility to obtain any other applicable permits and/or approvals from regulatory agencies with respect to the activities approved under this permit.

Please note that you must inform Environment and Climate Change Canada's Environmental Enforcement Division prior to and within 48 hours of, any loading for disposal. You must also submit a dredged material disposal plan to Environment and Climate Change Canada for approval prior to commencement of the first dredging operation authorized by this permit.

ECCC acknowledges the receipt of the full amount of the assessed fee (\$30,080) for this permit in accordance with the Disposal at Sea Permit Fee Regulations. A refund may be requested for every unused 1 000 m³ of the permit quantity. The refund request must accompany the final report detailing all work conducted under this permit. The request must be made in writing within 30 days of the expiration of the permit to Ms. Linda Porebski at Environment and Climate Change Canada, 351 St. Joseph Boulevard,

Please note that the Minister may suspend or revoke a permit or vary its terms and conditions with regard to the factors specified in Schedule 6 of *CEPA 1999* or in any report by a Board of Review established under Section 333 of *CEPA 1999*.
