This letter is to notify the Nunavut Impact Review Board (“NIRB”) that the Dewar Lakes Camp will be re-opening on July 8, 2018.

ValOre Metals Corporation (“ValOre,” formerly Kivalliq Energy Corporation) will be using the Dewar Lakes Camp to facilitate field exploration operations. The program activities and camp use are expected to last approximately two weeks.
