1. The tent-based camp will be set up on a slightly different location than the one originally proposed, and kept up an extra 4 months.
2. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [near Cambridge Bay]

The NPC previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal and a determination was issued on Apr 1, 2016 (NPC file 148210); renewed Jan. 27 2017 (NPC file 148444) and again renewed Apr 16, 2018 (NPC file 148829). The project is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.

In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 16YN019).

This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that changes to the camp do not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
