The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) previously screened works and activities associated with the current proposal, including the construction of a new sewage lagoon (NIRB FILE NO. 13UN032).

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because of the inclusion of a sludge drying pit, removal of contaminated soil, and spill remediation.

The above-noted project proposal requires screening by the NIRB under section 12.4.3 of the Nunavut Agreement as amended because it is for a component or activity that was not part of the original proposal and its inclusion is a significant modification of the project.
