PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “New Landfill and Waste Transfer Station” project is located within the Qikiqtani region, , approximately 8 kilometres (km) northwest of the City of Iqaluit. The Proponent intends to amend the scope of previously approved activities to construct a new landfill and a waste transfer station as part of the City of Iqaluit’s Solid Waste Management Initiative. The construction will begin in July 2019 and the landfill will have a service life of 75 years. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of a landfill
- Construction of a Waste Transfer Station
- Decommissioning of existing landfill
- Use of LDP Plastic Bale wrapping machine for compacting waste into bales
