#### PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed "Hood River Gold Project" is located within the Kitikmeot region, approximately 200 kilometres (km) southeast from Kugluktuk. The Proponent intends to conduct exploration related activities to assess previously identified gold targets and identify and explore new gold targets. The program is proposed to take place from June 2019 to June 2024. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Conduct prospecting, airborne and groundbased geophysical surveys;
- Establishment of a temporary seasonal camp and associated facilities to accommodate 60 personnel;
- Conduct on-land and on-ice drilling exploration activities;
- Use of existing airstrip on adjacent property (Ulu property) or alternatively use of an adjacent lake to the camp
