

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Scope:

The proposed “Iqaluit Quarry Area 1 and Area 2” project is located within the Qikiqtani (South Baffin) Region, approximately two (2) kilometres (km) northwest from Iqaluit. The Proponent intends to extract aggregate to meet the construction demands of the community of Iqaluit. The program is proposed to take place from 2019 until the projected deposit of aggregate is depleted or no longer needed.

According to the project proposal, the scope of the project includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of existing municipal roads to access the quarry sites located northwest of Iqaluit;
- Extraction of aggregate at Quarry Area 1 and Quarry Area 2 at depths of one (1) to three (3) metres (m);
- Use of heavy equipment to extract and transport aggregate material to sites as needed;
- Use of industrial vehicles, heavy equipment, and passenger vehicles for personnel transportation, quarry site operations, and aggregate hauling;
- Use of local fuel to operate heavy equipment and vehicle needs; and
- Reclamation of quarry sites following closure (once aggregate resources are depleted) by levelling the quarry.

At this time, the NIRB has identified no additional works or activities in relation to the project proposal. As a result, the NIRB will proceed with screening the project based on the scope as described above.

- Whether the project proposal is likely to cause significant adverse impacts on wildlife habitat or Inuit harvest activities; and if so, why;
- Whether the project proposal is of a type where the potential adverse effects are highly predictable and mitigable with known technology, (and providing any recommended mitigation measures); and
- Any matter of importance to the Party related to the project proposal.
