PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Arviat Fuel Capacity Increase” project is located within the Kivalliq region, located within Arviat. The Proponent intends to build a new tank farm and decommission the existing resupply pipeline and tank farm. The program is proposed to take place from May 2023 to October 2025. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of a new tank farm including construction of access road;
- Construction of a containment area, new tank foundations and concrete apron for tank refuelling;
- Construction of three (3) 3.333 million litre diesel storage tanks with associated fill and supply piping;
- Construction of one (1) 3.333 million litre gasoline storage tank with associated fill and supply piping;
