PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Community Access Trail” project is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 15 kilometres (km) from Naujaat. The Proponent intends to develop, operate and maintain a 15 km all-weather community access road with a bridge and multiple culverts following an existing all-terrain vehicle (ATV) trail. The program is proposed to take place from August 2019 to October 2019. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of a 15 km all weather access road
- Eight (8) borrow sites and other gravel quarries along the road alignment and any access roads as required;
- Potential for blasting of bedrock exposures to make riprap and rock fills; and
- Construction of a clear span bridge.
