**RE: NPC File # 149124 [Iqaluit Marine Infrastructure - Small Craft Harbour]**

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Marine based Infrastructure development: Extension to the existing breakwater, a boat launching ramp, improvement and expansion of parking/storage area at the municipal breakwater and potential improvements to the Old Causeway. The Project is designed to serve small boat users such as recreational users, hunters and fishermen, subsistence harvesters, marine outfitters and cruise ship tenders.
2. Associated NPC FILE No: 148431; Associated NIRB FILE No: 17XN022.
3. Summary of modification: Design changes have been made to extend the footprint of the Northmart breakwater from 1200m<sup>2</sup> to 4000m<sup>2</sup>; add a snowmobile ramp; extend the staging lanes; and enlarge the access to the North Breakwater and make the surface driveable to all vehicles.
4. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [Iqaluit]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The NPC previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal including the extension of the municipal breakwater and improvements to the Old Causeway, and a determination was issued on February 15, 2017 (NPC file 148431) that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.

In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 17XN022).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that the proposed modifications do not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.
