## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Igluligaarjuk Midnight Sun” project is located within the Kivalliq region, within the municipal boundary of Chesterfield Inlet. The Proponent intends to construct a 609 kilowatt (kW) solar array to supply power to Chesterfield Inlet and to reduce the communities reliance on diesel. The program is proposed to take place from April 2022 to September 2032. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Site surveys to identify location for solar array and related infrastructure;
- Installation of a 609 kW solar array;
- Construction of a corridor for road access and powerlines connecting to existing infrastructure in Chesterfield Inlet; and
- Use of facilities in Chesterfield Inlet for accommodations, water source, and waste management, and purchasing of local supplies for local and non-local construction workers.
