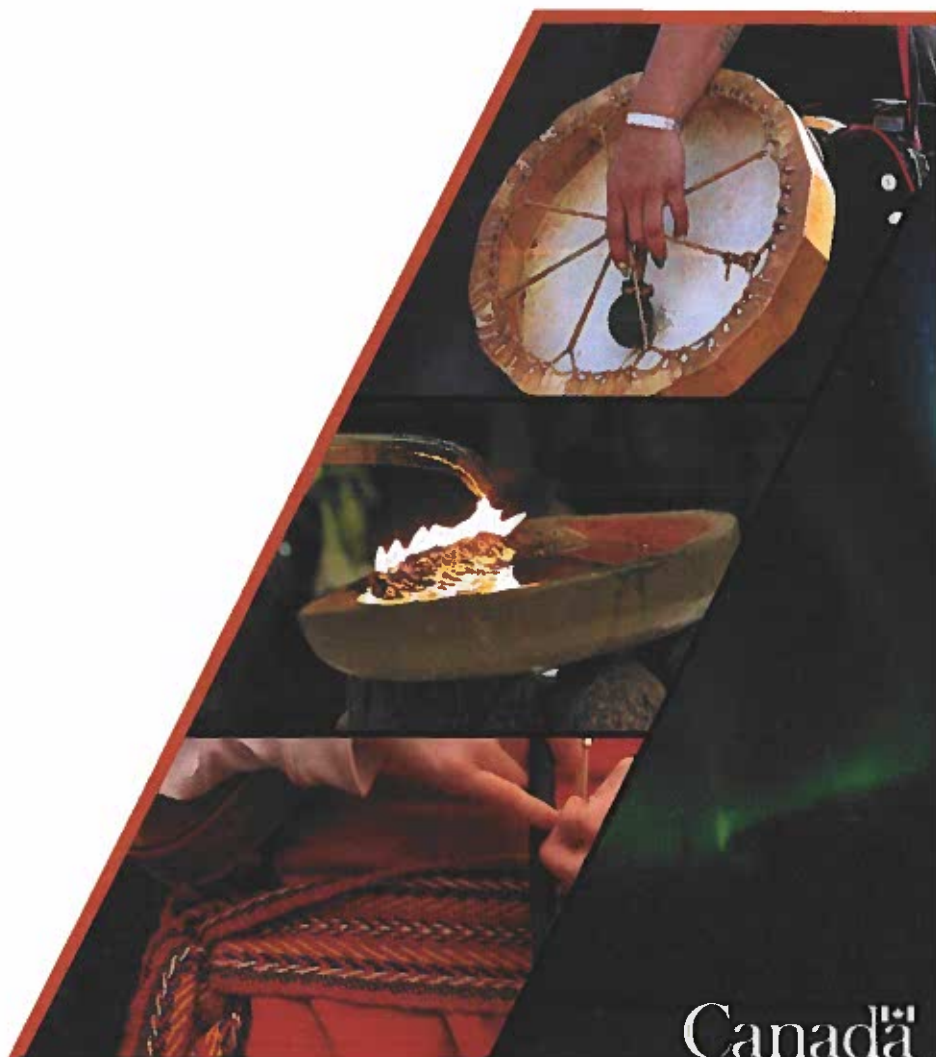




# CIRNAC COMMENTS TO NIRB

Re: Notice of Screening for iSolara Solar Power's  
"Igluligaarjuk Midnight Sun" Project Proposal



**Any matter of importance to the Party related to the project proposal:**

Although the Proponent has mentioned in the project application that there "may be impacts on the local environment", specific details have not been clearly identified. In the project applications impact matrix the impacts: noise, air quality, and archaeological and cultural historic sites are identified during the construction phase of this project and shown to be impacts which are negative and non-mitigatable, however, mitigations are not discussed.

The Proponent states that:

"During preliminary project phases, an extensive site assessment will be conducted to investigate environmental factors affecting the project and potential impacts the project could have on the local environment including: geotechnical study, review of heritage data, wildlife and plant screening, local habitat conditions study, and any natural features that could be affected by the project."

As the assessment of environmental impacts and potential mitigation measures has not been submitted as part of the project application CIRNAC cannot provide comments, or further address the NIRB's questions at this time.
