Therefore, it is in MUN's best interest to cure the identified information deficiencies in a timely manner.

1. TOPIC/ISSUE: NIRB’s Online Application Form

- Project Authorizations required for the research project (e.g., Scientific Research Licence from the Nunavut Research Institute), under the “Activities” tab;
- Community Involvement and/or community consultation conducted or to be conducted, under the “Activities” tab;
- Total number of days on site, under the “Details/Personnel” tab;
- Fuel and hazardous materials usage associated with the project, under the “Materials and Waste” tab, if applicable. If no usage for the project, reference to MSV Botnica sufficient;
- Detailed types of waste associated with the project, under the “Materials and Waste” tab, if applicable. If no wastes for the project, reference to MSV Botnica sufficient;
- A disclaimer regarding the use of the MSV Botnika, which has been previously screened by the NIRB, under the “Additional Information” tab.

The Proponent is recommended to review the Help Boxes associated with the NIRB’s online application form when completing the application.
