My name is Cory Barker and I am the Technical Advisor with the Nunavut Impact Review Board who will be working on your application for Memorial University's "Testing an industrial vessel of opportunity model for ship-time access to survey Canadian Arctic gateway ecosystems using baited remote underwater video".
